STORY LINES

- This is the fourth meeting all-time between Florida Tech and Valdosta State. The Blazers have dominated the series, winning all three matchups.
- The two sides met in last season's regular season finale, with GSC title implications on the line for FIT. E.J. Hilliard let the Blazers to victory with 294 yards passing and two touchdowns, adding 55 yards and a score on the ground.
- Kenny Johnston added a spark to the Panther air attack, catching five passes for 128 yards, including a 76-yard touchdown. Chris Stapleton led the defense with nine tackles, including a TFL.
- The Panthers are 7-5 all-time against teams from the state of Georgia. FIT owns four wins over Shorter and four wins over Shorter, while claiming a 1-2 record against West Georgia and a 0-3 mark against the Blazers.
- This game pits the GSC's No. 1 and No. 7 rushing offenses against each other. The Panthers lead the conference with 198.9 rushing yards per game, compared to 119.1 per contest from VSU. FIT is also No. 1 in the GSC in rushing defense at 81.4 yards per game, while the Blazers rank sixth, allowing 139.9 yards per game.

PANTHERS IN THE POLLS

Following last Saturday's loss to West Alabama, Florida Tech fell out of both the AFCA Division II Coaches' Poll and the D2Football.com Poll. The Panthers, however, did receive four votes in the AFCA rankings.

Fellow GSC schools North Alabama and Valdosta State appear in both polls, while West Alabama picked up five votes in the AFCA poll.

HERO SPORTS RANKINGS

Florida Tech fell four spots in the Hero Sports Division II Football Rankings last week, coming in at No. 14. The Panthers are joined in the rankings by fellow GSC members North Alabama (1), Valdosta State (10) and West Georgia (23).

OFFENSE CLICKING ON ALL CYLINDERS

Despite suffering a 45-35 defeat to West Alabama, Florida Tech's offense put up some eye-popping numbers. Mark Cato broke the school-record for passing yards in the game with 502, while the 643 yards of total offense was the most in the program's four years. In fact, the Panthers' offensive output is the second most in the conference this year, outdone only by North Alabama's 653 yards against North Greenville later that night.

KNACK FOR THE FORCED FUMBLE

Defensive lineman Adonis Davis has proven that he is constantly on the lookout for the opportunity to poke the ball loose. The Iowa Western Community College transfer ranks 12th in Division II in forced fumbles at 0.43 per game.

AIRING IT OUT

Florida Tech gunslinger Mark Cato continues to show he throws one of the best deep balls in D2. The redshirt-junior ranks second in the nation in passing yards per completion at a 17.41 clip and passing yards per attempt at 10.45 per pass.

Cato's favorite target, Kenny Johnston, is 5th in Division II in yards per reception at 24.07, leading the conference.

BEND DON'T BREAK

Florida Tech ranks fourth in NCAA Division II in red zone defense, allowing a score just 54.5 percent of the time when its opponent gets inside the 20-yard line. Panther opponents have scored just 12 times in 22 appearances in the red zone.

A LITTLE OF THIS, A LITTLE OF THAT

Antwuan Haynes has proven to be Florida Tech's do-everything back. Haynes averages the 22nd most all-purpose yards in the nation with 155.00 per game, 3rd most in the GSC. Haynes has racked up 512 rushing yards and 273 yards receiving.

THE CAPTAINS

Florida Tech will have three captains in 2016. Linebacker Chris Stapleton and defensive lineman Skylar Sheffield return to the role after serving as captains in 2015. Receiver Wayne Saunders II is the newcomer to the list, being voted as captain by his teammates. Additionally, the Panthers will name a fourth captain the night before each game.



PANTHERS PICKED THIRD IN GSC

Entering its fourth season, the Florida Tech football team has been picked to finish third in the Gulf South Conference by the GSC member coaches.

The Panthers garnered 48 points in the 2016 GSC Football Preseason Coaches Poll, including a pair of first place votes. Defending national semifinalist West Georgia tops the poll after receiving the other four first place votes.

Florida Tech was picked sixth in the Gulf South Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll prior to each of the program's first two seasons before moving up to fifth in 2015.

PRESEASON ALL-GSC TEAM

Florida Tech landed eight players on the 2016 Preseason All-Gulf South Conference Team, the most of any conference school.

For the second-straight year redshirt-senior running back Trevor Sand landed on the list. Despite missing three games due to injury, the Seminole, Florida native led the Panthers in rushing with 737 yards, finding the end zone three times.

Fresh off of a breakout season in 2014, tight end Kenny Johnston receives preseason all-conference designation. Johnston led the GSC in receiving touchdowns with 10, racking up a team-high 787 yards.

Many times the players opening up holes and providing protection to allow for big plays go unnoticed. That isn't the case for Florida Tech, as three members of the Panthers' offensive line were honored in Kevin Delgado, Blake Stone and Matt Nelson.

On the defensive side, defensive back Manny Abad repeats as all-conference. Abad tied for second in the GSC in pass breakups with 10 and tied for third in passes defended with 11.

Linebacker Chris Stapleton makes an appearance on the preseason all-conference list. The Navarre, Florida native ranked third in the GSC in tackles with 89.

Safety Trai Cadore wraps up the FIT honorees. The Cocoa High School product was one of two Panthers with multiple interceptions in 2015.

Johnston, Nelson and Stapleton are among a group of 13 unanimous selections

Additionally, the GSC listed the conference's top newcomers from each team for the upcoming season. For FIT, sophomore linebacker Donald Styles III, junior receiver Romell Guerrier and junior defensive back Joe Jackson made the cut.

JOHNSTON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

Unlike a year ago, FIT tight end Kenny Johnston will not come into the season under the radar. After proving himself as one of the top pass catchers at his position in the nation, the redshirt-senior was named to the FootballGamePlan.com Preseason All-American Team.

Johnston was one of three tight ends honored, joined by Ashland's Adam Shaeen and Southern Arkansas's Tanner Hudson.

GSC GAME OF THE WEEK RENEWED

The Gulf South Conference has officially announced the schedule for the 12th edition of its Florida's Space Coast GSC Football Game of the Week featured live on ESPN3.

ESPN3 serves as the exclusive carrier of the league's package for the third consecutive season. This year's 10-game slate includes nine Saturday games and one Thursday night contest and kicks off on September 17 when Shorter University hosts Florida Tech in Rome, Ga.

Play-by-play commentator Don Russell and color commentator Rick Rhodes will continue to lead the coverage from the booth and Gulf Coast Mobile, L.L.C. will produce the package for the fifth year in a row.

Fans can access each contest on the GSC's official ESPN3 page at gscsports.org/ESPN3 or visiting WatchESPN.com.

FIT will be featured three times this season, tied with West Alabama for the most in the conference. The Panthers' contests with Shorter (Sept. 17), Valdosta State (Oct. 29) and Delta State (Nov. 12) will be featured.

PANTHERS ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

Florida Tech will play in front of a national audience three times in 2016. Fans will be able to watch the Panthers three times on WatchESPN and the ESPN App as part of the Florida's Space Coast GSC Game of the Week schedule. Additionally, the Panthers' matchup with new in-state rival West Florida (Oct. 1) will be part of the NCAA Division 2 Football Showcase and will be aired on the American Sports Network.

COASTAL CLASSIC

There's a new rivalry forming in the GSC, with West Florida becoming the second Division II football team in the Sunshine State. When the Panthers and Argonauts meet in October, the game will be dubbed the Coastal Classic, with both sides vying for an anchor themed trophy.

TEAM ADIDAS

The Panthers will wear three different sets of uniforms – crimson, gray and white – in 2016. All are part of the Adidas Shockweb collection.

With two helmets at their disposal - crimson and gray - FIT has its choice of 18 different uniform combinations.



TOP NOTCH COMPETITION

The Gulf South Conference has long been respected as one of the deepest and strongest conferences in all of NCAA Division II football. The conference has received some confirmation of this belief as Hero Sports lists the GSC number one in their conference power rankings.

The Lone Star Conference and South Atlantic Conference round out the top-3.

STAFF CHANGES

Florida Tech saw some changes to its staff in the lead up to the 2016 season.

Coming off of his first year in the program, Mark Smith will assume the duties of defensive coordinator, while remaining the Panthers' defensive line coach.

Graduate assistant Dan Owen has been given the duties of video coordinator in addition to his role as secondary coach.

Joe Stockton joins the FIT staff as wide receivers coach after spending the past three seasons at Limestone.

David Stuckman is the Panthers' new safeties coach, coming to FIT after a one-year stint at Louisiana Tech.

STEVE ENGLEHART

Head football coach Steve Englehart enters his fourth season at the helm of the Panther football team. During his first three seasons, Englehart has steered FIT to an 18-16 overall record, including a 9-11 record in Gulf South Conference action.

The program's third season was unquestionably its most successful, coming within one game of a conference championships and a postseason bid with a 7-4 record. The Panthers registered a pair of monumental wins during the campaign, becoming the first team to defeat then No. 5 Delta State on its home turf in over three years and knocking off the nation's No. 1 ranked team in West Georgia on Senior Day at Florida Tech Panther Stadium.

In 2014, Englehart's Panthers surprised and shook up the college football world. FIT notched its first-ever win over a ranked opponent with a thrilling 37-31 victory over No. 12 Tarleton State at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas, the home venue of the NFL's Dallas Cowboys. The following week the Panthers returned to the Sunshine State and narrowly dropped a game at Division I opponent Bethune Cookman after failing to convert a two-point attempt at the end of the game. The program tallied another first later in the year, garnering its first GSC road win with a dramatic 33-32 win at West Alabama. FIT finished the year with a 6-5 overall record and a 3-4 mark in the GSC.

Englehart led Florida Tech Football to a 5-7 record in the program's inaugural season in fall 2013. The Panthers' victories included their inaugural game against Stetson, a Gulf South Conference win versus Shorter, a Homecoming triumph over Warner, their last regular season game against Webber International and a victory in the first-ever Eastern College Athletic Conference Division II Futures Bowl over Alderson Broaddus.

Since he arrived at Florida Tech in 2011, he has built the program from the ground up. With the help of his staff, he has recruited over 110 new student-athletes, fundraised for the new Varsity Training Center, been heavily involved with the Brevard County community and traveled throughout the state of Florida to promote Florida Tech Football.

Prior to settling in Melbourne, Englehart was the offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Indiana State University, in 2010. His unit set program records, scoring 351 points and 48 touchdowns, and averaged the 17th-most yards in the Football Championship Subdivision at 411.8 yards per game. Running back Darrius Gates excelled under Englehart as he averaged 10.6 points per game, which led the Missouri Valley Conference and was second at the FCS level.

Englehart also coached for four years at NCAA Division III Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology. At the time of his hiring, Englehart was the second youngest head coach in all of NCAA football at 28 years old. He guided the Fightin' Engineers to a 26-14 record. His .650 winning percentage is still the best in program history. During his last three years at Rose-Hulman, his players combined for 30 All-Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference awards. Englehart also coached quarterback Derek Eitel who graduated with every major career passing record, and was named HCAC Player of the Year in 2009.

Englehart played quarterback at Indiana State from 1996-99 where he ran the triple option. He earned letters in 97, 98, and 99. He was named to the Gateway Football Conference's All-Academic Team in 1998 and 1999, was named a GTE Scholar Athlete three times, and earned Sycamore Honor Athlete recognition for four seasons.

Englehart and his wife, Carrie, reside in Melbourne and have three children, Caden, Ty, and Lila.
