## A NEW GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE RIVALRY BEGINS

With tonight's matchup representing the first Gulf South Conference skirmish in West Florida football history, the contest already represents a historic one before it even begins.

The Blazers enter the game looking to avenge a tough road loss last week against the rival Lions of North Alabama, where Valdosta State periodically surged on offense throughout but struggled to find the endzone. In fact, the Blazers outgained the Lions by nearly 75 yards, a stat which failed to reflect the lopsided 44-19 result in favor of UNA.

This week, the Blazers will face a familiar foe at the quarterback position in the form of Kaleb Nobles, who served as a backup quarterback for Valdosta State throughout the previous two seasons. Nobles has been a force so far this year for UWF, and even claimed a GSC Player of the Week honor on September 12th in recognition of a performance against Missouri S&T that included career highs of 503 passing yards and six touchdown passes. His yardage in that game represented the ninth-highest single game total in Gulf South Conference history, and his touchdown total marked the seventh-most.

Under this year's new coaching staff, a period of progression is expected for Valdosta State. With conference play in full force now, however, the Blazers will need to right the ship quickly. To do so, the Blazers will aim to improve their red zone performance after a host of missed opportunities last week against UNA. Valdosta State made their way into the red zone six different times in the contest but were denied a touchdown on five of those chances.

Expect Valdosta State to continue to utilize wide receiver Damien Strange, who has recently emerged as a primary target among the Valdosta State receiving corps. Strange, a senior transfer out of Williston, Fla. currently leads the team in both receptions with 10 and receiving yards with 179. His average of 17.90 yards per catch places him first on the team, and he currently ranks third in the Gulf South Conference with an average of 89.5 receiving yards per game.

## QUICK NOTES

- Valdosta State is now in its 35th year of intercollegiate football and owns an overall record of 268 wins, 120 losses and four ties.
- The Blazers' new mantra this year is "New era. Same tradition." With the exception of Jeremy Darveau, the Blazer coaching staff features an entirely new lineup, consisting of four new assistant coaches. The group is led by Kerwin Bell, who was named the program's new head coach in January, and will serve as the eighth head coach in a line of Valdosta State Football head coaches.
- The Blazers have scored points in 296 straight games, which represents a Division II Football record. The last time the Blazers were shutout was in the 1991 season opener against Central Florida.
- Over the course of the first two games, Damien Strange has emerged as a primary target among the Valdosta State receiving corps. Strange, a senior transfer out of Williston, Fla. currently leads the team in both receptions with 10 and receiving yards with 179. His average of 17.90 yards per catch places him first on the team, and he currently ranks third in the Gulf South Conference with an average of 89.5 receiving yards per game.
- Valdosta State football's winning percentage of .685 places them second all-time at the Division II level. The only program with a higher winning percentage is Grand Valley State. The Lakers have a record of 374-137-3, which tops Division II with a .729 winning percentage.
- Sophomore quarterback Adam Robles saw his first action as a Blazer after Head Coach Kerwin Bell called his number to begin the second half of last week's matchup against North Alabama. The University of South Florida transfer responded favorably, completing his very first pass to Dallas Baldner on the right side. Robles went on to complete 15-of-33 attempts for 187 passing yards and a touchdown, also to Baldner.

## SERIES HISTORY AGAINST WEST FLORIDA

### BLAZERS MAKE THE POINT

Known for its offense, Valdosta State is the current NCAA Division II leader in games without being shutout as the Blazers have scored in each of their last 296 games. The last time VSU was shutout was on September 14, 1991 when UCF defeated the Blazers 12-0 in Orlando, Fla.

### BLAZERS AMONG THE NATIONS BEST

Now in its 35th year of football, Valdosta State ranks among the top schools in the nation in terms of all-time winning percentage. In fact, only one school - Grand Valley State - has a better all-time winning percentage than the Blazers, whose 259-116-3 all-time record accounts for a .685 winning percentage. ### ONE OF THE BEST SINCE 2000

Much of the Blazers' all-time winning percentage ranking can be attributed to Valdosta State's play since the beginning of the 2000 season, as only two Division II teams have won more games during that period. The Blazers have tallied 156 wins over the course of the last 15 seasons, behind only Grand Valley State's 181 and Northwest Missouri State's 178. GVSU (.848), NMSU (.850) and Tuskegee (.805) are the only teams with a better winning percentage than Valdosta State's .799. Below is a look at the top five in the nation in each category since the beginning of 2000:

### BLAZERS PICKED TO FINISH FIFTH IN GSC

Preseason All-Gulf South Conference pick Kenny Moore and the Valdosta State football team will enter the 2016 campaign with something to prove, according to a poll taken of the Gulf South Conference coaches, as the Blazers were picked to finish fifth in the league in a release by the GSC on Wednesday.

Despite a preseason national ranking at No. 13 in the 2016 Lindy's Sports Magazine Preseason Division II poll, the Blazers picked up two third place votes, four fourth place votes and two fifth place votes for 40 total points. As a result, VSU trailed Delta State, who fell into fourth place with 46 points (one second place vote, five third place votes, one fourth place vote, one fifth place vote). Florida Tech edged out DSU by a narrow margin in third place with 48 points (two first place votes, one second place vote, one third place vote, three fourth place votes, one fifth place vote), while North Alabama came in second with 53 points (six second place votes, one third place vote, one fourth place vote). West Georgia topped the preseason list for the second straight season with 63 points (seven first place votes, one second place vote).

Rounding out the poll in the bottom four positions were West Alabama in sixth place with 26 points, followed by Mississippi College, West Florida, and Shorter in the bottom three with 21, 16, and 11 points, respectively.

### ONE BLAZER NAMED PRESEASON ALL-GSC

As for individual honors, the Blazers were represented by Moore, a local product out of Lowndes High School who is preparing for his senior season. Moore established himself as one of the top defensive backs in the GSC after a stellar 2015 season, in which the Titledown native snatched three interceptions and returned two for touchdowns. Additionally, Moore recorded a career high 51 tackles last season to extend his career total beyond the century mark at 106, and earned All-GSC and All-Super Region II honors as a result. Moore was one of just five defensive players to be chosen as a unanimous pick in the poll, voted on each preseason by coaches throughout the GSC.

### NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Overall, VSU has tallied an 94-34-1 record all-time in non-conference games, a winning percentage of .734 in non-GSC games.

Under former head coach **David Dean**, VSU compiled a 37-7 record and an .860 winning percentage during his nine year stint. Of the six losses under Dean, three came against GSC foes during the NCAA playoffs, which rendered the contest a non-conference matchup.

Hosted by Dick Rockey, The Kerwin Bell Show will be available to watch on demand each week at [www.vsublazerfootball.com](http://www.vsublazerfootball.com). The show will be filmed on location following each contest, and will be posted no later than the following Monday each week. The show includes feature packages on various Blazer Athletics events, while also giving an in-depth look at the VSU game from the previous week.

The Kerwin Bell Radio Show will air each Monday night at 7:00 p.m. and is hosted by Marty McGhin. The show airs live on 105.9 FM in Valdosta and will broadcast live from the Coyocan Restaurant in Valdosta. The hour-long program features analysis from Bell as well as a question and answer time at the end of the program.

### THE BLAZERS AT HOME

Valdosta State has won 145 of 192 games, with 44 losses and one tie (.754), on its home field since beginning football in 1982. The Blazers are an impressive 135-44-1 (.749) at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium and have a 9-4 (.692) at Martin Stadium.

VSU has gone undefeated at home seven times (5-0 in 2006, 6-0 in 2004, 9-0 in 2002, 5-0 in 1995, 8-0 in 1994, 3-0-1 in 1992 and 5-0 in 1986) in its 29-year history. The Blazers have been particularly successful at home since the beginning of the 2000 season as they have tallied a 76-19 record (.800) during that span.

### THE GSC IN THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Only three teams in the Gulf South Conference have made appearances in the Division II National Championship. Delta State appeared in both the 2000 and 2010 title games, while North Alabama (1985, '93, '94, '95) and Valdosta State (2002, '04, '07, '12) have each appeared four times. The Blazers and the Lions have each won three titles, and DSU has won once.

### KENNY MOORE NAMED PRESEASON ALL-GSC

Preseason All-Gulf South Conference pick Kenny Moore and the Valdosta State football team will enter the 2016 campaign with something to prove, according to a poll taken of the Gulf South Conference coaches, as the Blazers were picked to finish fifth in the league in a release by the GSC on Wednesday.

Despite a preseason national ranking at No. 13 in the 2016 Lindy's Sports Magazine Preseason Division II poll, the Blazers picked up two third place votes, four fourth place votes and two fifth place votes for 40 total points. As a result, VSU trailed Delta State, who fell into fourth place with 46 points (one second place vote, five third place votes, one fourth place vote, one fifth place vote). Florida Tech edged out DSU by a narrow margin in third place with 48 points (two first place votes, one second place vote, one third place vote, three fourth place votes, one fifth place vote), while North Alabama came in second with 53 points (six second place votes, one third place vote, one fourth place vote). West Georgia topped the preseason list for the second straight season with 63 points (seven first place votes, one second place vote).

Rounding out the poll in the bottom four positions were West Alabama in sixth place with 26 points, followed by Mississippi College, West Florida, and Shorter in the bottom three with 21, 16, and 11 points, respectively.

As for individual honors, the Blazers were represented by Moore, a local product out of Lowndes High School who is preparing for his senior season. Moore established himself as one of the top defensive backs in the GSC after a stellar 2015 season, in which the Tipton native snatched three interceptions and returned two for touchdowns. Additionally, Moore recorded a career high 51 tackles last season to extend his career total beyond the century mark at 106, and earned All-GSC and All-Super Region II honors as a result. Moore was one of just five defensive players to be chosen as a unanimous pick in the poll, voted on each preseason by coaches throughout the GSC.

"I just want to honor God and my family for pushing me to standards that I would not have reached on my own," said Moore on Wednesday after learning of the honor. "I didn't do any of this on my own, and I give all the credit back to the people who made me who I am along the way. As a team, we to come together and motivate one another in order to be successful."
