TO THE WORKING MEDIA

PRESS BOXES/PRESS ROW: Cleveland Field and Bazemore-Hyder Stadium, the football home of the Valdosta State Blazers, is topped on both sides by press boxes built to accommodate event personnel. The booth on the south (home) side will house game operations, media, sports information, home coaches, home radio, and filmers for both teams. The booth on the north (visitor) side houses visiting coaches, visiting radio, film crews for coaches' shows and television stations.

The Complex, which serves as the home for VSU basketball and volleyball, has seating for all visiting media along its press row/scorer's table area. Phone lines and electricity are available, as is wireless internet access.

Billy Grant Field, home of Blazer baseball, and the VSU Softball Complex each feature press box areas immediately behind home plate. Each area is equipped with phone lines and wireless internet access.

The VSU Soccer Complex, home of Blazer soccer, feature a press box area above the home stands on the east side of the facility. Seating is available for both media and sports information, and wireless internet access is available.

Standard services are provided in all VSU press box/press row areas for media personnel - including flip cards, cumulative statistics, media guides, programs, and play-by-play accounts, abbreviated statistics at halftime and complete final statistics as soon as possible at the end of each event.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS: Contact Matt Malone, SID, for press passes as far in advance as possible. Passes will be mailed if time permits. If not, they will be left at Will Call at each venue.

RADIO: A modular plug phone line is provided for the official broadcast team of the opponent for each game. The visiting radio crew will work from the lower level of the north-side press box for football, from the left (visiting) end of press row in The Complex and from the right booths at baseball and softball. All visiting radio crews should contact Matt Malone, SID, for credentials prior to the event.

FILM: Official game filmers will shott from the press box on the south side of the field for all football games. Coaches' show filmers and television film crews will use the film deck on the second level of the north side press box. Media can also film from either sideline (goal line to the 25-yard lines). While it is necessary to walk throught the team area to get from one end of the field to the other, photographers and film crews are not permitted to shoot within the team area (from 25-yard line to 25-yard line).

SCOUTS: Requests for scouting credentials should be made directly to Matt Malone, SID, early during the week of the game to be scouted in order to allow time for mailing of credentials. Scouts will be provided seats in the press box only if room is available.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS: All player interviews should be scheduled through Matt Malone, SID. Please allow the player at least 24 hours advance notice for phone interviews. All game day interviews of VSU athletes and coaches will occur after the game, unless previously scheduled through the Sports Information Office.

INTERVIEWING VALDOSTA STATE'S COACHING STAFF: Valdosta State's head coaches are available for interview throughout the day. Please contact the Sports Information Office to schedule these interviews.

PRACTICE COVERAGE: All Valdosta State practices are open to the media, unless otherwise noted by the coaching staff. Matt Malone, SID, will assist in setting up interviews with requested players and/or coaches at the conclusion of each practice. For better service, please let the Sports Information Office know in advance when you will attend practice.

THE VSU FOOTBALL RADIO NETWORK

WDDQ Talk 92.1 FM in Valdosta and Adel is in its fifth year as the flagship station for the Blazers. Additionally, WVOH 93.5 Hazlehurst, WKZZ 92.5 Tifton, WRDO 96.9 Fitzgerald, WJHC Talk 107.5 Jasper, FL, WSFB 1490AM/97.7FM Quitman, WJEM 1150AM The Jock/96.1FM in Valdosta also carry all VSU football games. Dick Rockey serves as the play-by-play voice of Blazer football, while Tom Odom and Spencer Van Horn provide color commentary.

THE VSU BASKETBALL RADIO NETWORK

WDDQ Talk 92.1 FM in Valdosta and Adel is also the flagship station for Blazer and Lady Blazer basketball games. Mike Chason and Matt Malone serve as the commentary team.

THE VSU BASEBALL / SOFTBALL RADIO NETWORK

WDDQ Talk 92.1 FM in Valdosta and Adel is also the flagship station for Blazer Baseball/ Softball. Dick Rockey and Bill Malone have the call for baseball events, while Matt Malone handles play-by-play duties for softball games.

THE BLAZERS ON THE WEB

Through VSU's partnership with US Education TV, both live and archived VSU events can be seen by way of links provided on the front page and schedule pages for each sport at www.vstateblazers.com. The website features live and archived coverage of select Volleyball, Football, Soccer, Men's and Women's Basketball, Softball, and Baseball games throughout the athletic season. A schedule of upcoming webcasts can be found on the main page of the Valdosta State Athletics website. Blazer Athletics aims to round out its coverage of all home events this season with the addition of a partnership with livestream.com, which will feature additional broadcasts of volleyball, soccer, softball, baseball, and tennis contests. Links for every available event can be found at www.vstateblazers.com. The Kerwin Bell Show is filmed shortly after each game and can be seen on demand at www.vsufootball.com. New editions of the weekly show are posted no later than each Monday during the football season.

At the 6th light, turn right on Oak St. Turn left at light on to Brookwood Dr. Cross under next light (Patterson St.), and then dead end at Williams St. Note: This is the NE corner of stadium.

Mary St., Valdosta, GA 31601

From I-75 at Exit 22, head east. (At 4th light, veer right) Go through 8th light, Billy Grant Field will be on your left (directly across from Valdosta Middle School). Approximately 4 miles from the interstate. 2601 N. Patterson St., Valdosta, GA 31602

To The Softball Complex

-#3 on the Campus Map on page 11-

From I-75 at Exit 22, head east (At 4th light, veer right). Go through 8th light, the field is located directly behind the baseball field. The team may drive down the gravel driveway and park adjacent to the softball field. Spectators need to use the baseball parking lot and walk down the paved path to the entrance gate for softball. Approximately 4 miles from the interstate.





The Athletic Field House

The home to the Valdosta State football and women's soccer programs is the Valdosta State Athletic Field House. The 41,000 square foot Field House opened in January 2009 at a cost of \$5.8 million, giving the Blazer program one of the top athletic facilities in the nation. Beyond football and soccer, the field house also houses the 7,690 square foot Jessie Tuggle Weight Room and a 2,437 square foot state-of-the-art Athletic Training Room that is


used by all VSU teams. The Tuggle Weight Room which encases nearly 10 times the space of its predecessor is one of, if not the top, weight facilities among NCAA Division II schools nationwide. It features 10 brand new eight-post stations as well as a reinforced medicine ball wall. New self-contained dumbbell stations were also added to the area while a 30-yard speed track was included in the design of the floor. The Weight Room also features elliptical machines and stationary bikes for cardio workouts and a built-in microphone/stereo system to aid the strength and conditioning staff while working with large groups of VSU athletes. Additionally, each of the 10 eight-post stations has also been pre-wired for video recording, which will be added in the near future, for further evaluation and instruction by the strength and conditioning staff. The newest addition to the facility are two Cognisens "caves," which allow for an increased mental training to provide Blazer athletes with an additional edge in competition. Valdosta State is the only university on any level in the nation to own the Cognisens machines, with additional owners including Manchester United and multiple NHL hockey teams. Next door to the Tuggle Weight Room is the Athletic Training Room. The area includes offices for the Valdosta State Athletic Training staff and a private physician exam room as well as a hydrotherapy room for rehabilitation work. The main Athletic Training area features six taping stations as well as six additional treatment areas plus a cardiovascular/rehabilitation area featuring stationary bikes. Additionally, outside of the facility is the space to add two lighted football practice fields, which are planned for completion in the near future, as well as, a soccer stadium.

FOOTBALL

The new Athletic Field House features many amenities that will aid the football team as it endures the rigors of a football season. A 3,265 square foot locker room is the centerpiece of the project and is lined with 126 lockers, enough to house all members of the VSU football squad. Adjacent to the locker room is a 2,100 square foot equipment room with secure "pass-through" equipment bins that allow managers to address the equipment needs of all the Blazers while keeping each player's equipment separated. The remainder of the Athletic Field House includes a 3,458 square foot office suite for the football coaches as well as 2,200 square feet of meeting rooms, each equipped with state-of-the-art video equipment. The academic needs of the student-athlete are also addressed as a 1,500 square foot computer lab is equipped with 19 computers.

WOMEN'S SOCCER

The Athletic Field House also includes a 2,800 square foot suite for the women's soccer program at VSU. The soccer suite includes offices for the soccer head coach and assistant coach, as well as, Valdosta State's locker room and a team room. Equipment storage space is also included in the area, as well as, a visitor's locker room and an official's locker room.




V STATE CAMPUS MAP
